



Ear Infections

Definition

Ear Infections or Otitis media is an inner ear infection generally caused by a blockage of the Eustachian tubes. The Eustachian Tube allows equalized pressure on the eardrum and allows fluid to drain away from the inner ear. When the Eustachian tube is blocked, fluid builds up and causes an infection.

A common treatment is the use of oral antibiotics. As most parents can attest, this is often ineffective. In fact, the use of amoxicillin and other antibiotics can actually prolong the problem and increase the chance of reoccurrence.
